

For prayer and reflection...From the South Australian Council of Churches:



This week, as the Orthodox Churches celebrate Easter, we share a beautiful Coptic Icon, written by the late Coptic Iconographer, Isaac Fanous [1919-2007]. Dr Heshmat Keroloss, Theologian, Coptic Orthodox Church, writes, "It shows our Lord Jesus taking Adam and Eve out of Hades. When Jesus died on the cross, His human soul went down to Hades like all human souls. But because Jesus' soul was united to His divinity, it was impossible for Hades to capture it [Acts 2:31]. Rather, he freed the righteous souls which repented and died in the hope of the

coming of the Messiah.

This is related to our theme [of this year's Ecumenical Lenten Resource], Return to God: *Divine Grace and Human Struggle*, because repentance itself cannot free us from corruption without God's saving act and grace, even though human part remains necessary." Alleluia, alleluia.
