Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,
The Red Dove Cafe is located within the Royal Adelaide Showgrounds at Wayville. The cafe has been an exemplary supporter of missional projects across South Australia since its inception in 1951. The Red Dove Cafe has raised millions of dollars for different ministries including: prison chaplaincy, mental health/disability chaplaincy and a variety of different community support services.

From its establishment, the Red Dove Cafe has given 100% of profits to charity and has always been resourced by dedicated volunteers - some for many years. Students from Westminster, Pedare, Annesley and Lincoln Colleges – have also contributed to staffing the cafe.

The cafe serves home-style food to showgoers and exhibitors and is a friendly gathering place, in one of the busiest, most vibrant parts of the show – sideshow alley.

At the end of the 2016 Royal Adelaide Show, the historical Red Dove Cafe is to be demolished and the venue will be relocated to another section of the showgrounds - yet to be determined. There will be an official closing of the building at the showgrounds on **2nd October at 2.30pm.**

Join me in praying for the ongoing future of the cafe and for those who generously donate their time and gifts to the successful operation of the Red Dove Cafe which has donated millions to ministry projects across South Australia for over 65 years.
