# Report to Congregation from the Property and Finance meeting held Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> July

A very large amount of work has been completed in the first 6 months of this year. We are very fortunate in having so many willing workers. The fact that people are prepared to turn out, often at short notice, and recently in poor weather, has been much appreciated.

A large number of small but important things have been completed and the major task of re-roofing of Wheatland House. This was a major cost but we were helped by a Heritage Grant from the Holdfast bay Council. Fences on the Southern and Western Boundary of the Wheatland House Property have been replaced and repaired. The path behind Wheatland has been repaired and bituminised.

The other major project has been the work on the gardens. The garden facing Acacia Road was barren and three of the five prunus dead or dying. The front garden facing Wheatland Street was very overgrown. The Acacia Street Garden has been planted and we have cleared the overgrown front garden.

The next task is to replant the front garden with smaller shrubs some of which will flower and be bird attracting and we are considering ways to achieve this. A few smaller tasks are planned for the near future and Von and Maureen will be organising a time to spring clean the Worship Centre.
