Winter Appeal – helping others one stitch at a time

Twenty knitted blankets are on their way to bringing warmth to people in need, thanks to the skill and generosity of a group of residents at Westminster Village Aged Care. Every Tuesday the residents gather to knit colourful squares, which are lovingly crocheted together to create blankets for UnitingSA's Emergency Relief centre.

Donations made to UnitingSA during winter go straight towards the UnitingSA's Winter Appeal, which supports almost 1500 people who require emergency relief such as, people who are homeless, at risk of becoming homeless, and those in financial hardship.

"There are people who are sleeping in their car or transitioning from homelessness to home," says Cindy, the anti-poverty team leader for UnitingSA, "these blankets will go to help those people. Children, in particular, love the colours and it really brightens their day."

Donations such as these can be brought to the UnitingSA's Emergency Relief Centre at 58 Dale St, Port Adelaide, between 9:00 am and 1:30 pm, Monday to Friday.
