# Solution of the Treasurer

- The total proceeds from the Craft Fair so far are \$2399.20. From this, I intend to deduct about \$100 for expenses including consumables, power and cleaning. In response to Heather Gepp's suggestion, Council have decided to allocate the nett proceeds (50:50) to our current Oodnadatta Mission Project and Kitchen Improvements (possibly a dishwasher) in due course.
- 2. Copies of various reports including the Financial Report for 2018 and our proposed budget for 2019, which I have prepared on your behalf, have been sent to most of you by email Rosemary. If you don't have a email a limited number will be available as paper copies from her today. This report has been seen and approved by both P&F and CC and I urge you to spend a few minutes having a careful look at the figures, in particular the estimated deficit. You are most welcome to make any comments/questions to me beforehand, or to our congregation during the AGM which will be held next Sunday.
- 3. Permission has been granted by CC for our Hall tenants to erect some **banners** on the Wheatland Fence for 2 weeks when they wish, in effort to attract people to their classes for 2019. I have offered to be responsible for this and details will be in the minutes or from any CC member.
