#### . LOOKING AHEAD....

Since the November 2018 decision of the SA Presbytery Synod a group of members have been involved in conversation about the formation of new presbyteries in SA. Two open gatherings have been held and over 200 UC members have provided feedback and insights about the vision and role of Presbyteries in the life of the Uniting Church. Many are looking forward to the formation of new presbyteries in 2020 and are convinced this will bring a renewed pastoral ethos through mutual caring and networking.

The group working on follow up to the meetings at Rosefield UC in February and The Corner in April have prepared a proposal to go to the June meeting of Presbytery-Synod. We believe this proposal summarizes insights from these gatherings and will assist congregations plan ahead.

The next gathering on 14<sup>th</sup> June will begin by outlining the steps taken to reach this point and invite questions and comments. We will then break into three working groups based on three regions in SA including rural and urban: North West, North East and South. Groups will consider the proposal to form three regional presbyters and the implications this has for strengthening and growing our vision for mission and ministry. As the Transitional Presbytery will meet on Saturday June 29<sup>th</sup> the June 14<sup>th</sup> gathering will provide background information in preparation for its considerations and decisions.

You and members of your congregation are invited to the gathering on **Friday June 14**<sup>th</sup> and this will be held at Adelaide West UC, Donald Bradman Drive, Brooklyn Park beginning at 7.00pm and concluding by 9.00pm.
