At its recent meeting, Church Council agreed to offer an invitation to all of our members, indeed to anyone interested, to become involved. We hope that everyone (max 100) will consider becoming involved in this way, it is not quite the 'real thing' but is much better than nothing and actually quite fun!

You will be able to log in on Sundays from about 9.15am (using the link below) but we found that the best way is to start viewing the video from the Church Website at 9.30am promptly, before clicking the link and joining 'the crowd' immediately afterwards for discussion of the 'Message' and then a virtual cuppa and chat for as long as you wish.

If you would like to be involved, these are the steps to follow:

- You can use any digital Device but it will need a camera and microphone and a bigger screen will be better so you can see everyone.
- 2. Go to: https://zoom.us/download and follow the prompts to download 'ZOOM Client for Meetings'. I suggest you avoid the other 'third parties' who also offer it.

4. I will then send you the link you will need to click on to join the 'meeting' or just click on the one below:
