#### The First and Second commandments Mt.22: 32 - 38

<sup>32</sup> I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.<sup>33</sup> And when the multitude heard this, they were astonished at his doctrine.<sup>34</sup> But when the Pharisees had heard that he had put the Sadducees to silence, they were gathered together.<sup>35</sup> Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,<sup>36</sup> Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

<sup>37</sup> Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.<sup>38</sup> This is the first and great commandment.<sup>39</sup> And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.<sup>40</sup> On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
