As advised last Sunday, I will seek a quick expression of opinion this Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> Feb, about whether we run one long meeting or conduct a follow-up meeting probably in mid March.

If you have a matter that you believe the congregation needs to discuss, please prepare a proposal and get it to me by this Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> Feb; doing that will help with pulling the agenda together.

Remember that an election for membership of **Church Council** will be conducted as part of the AGM. The nominees are Marg Davidson (nominating for a 3-year term), David Greig (3 years), Maureen Howland (3 years), Denise Phillips (2 years) and Andrew Telfer (3 years).

We received an additional nomination for Church Council last Sunday evening – as we were not able to make the necessary public announcement last Sunday, the plan is to hang on to nomination and conduct a follow-up election, probably also in mid March. Max

## CAN YOU HELP?

I have been contacted by a student from Tabor College who is currently completing formation as a Spiritual Director.

**Spiritual Direction is** one person inviting another person to accompany them on their faith journey.

This involves a **conversation** where:

- the 'guide' listens carefully to the 'pilgrim' **reflecting** on his/her daily life experiences
- both pilgrim and guide seek to pay attention to the presence of God in the pilgrim's life
- both are seeking to nurture the life of God in the pilgrim and to encourage the expression of this in ordinary and practical living

This student is at the point where they need to engage in and reflect on their practice of spiritual direction and she is seeking people who may be willing participants in this process. It will involve about an hour spent with the trainee director (who is supervised) every six weeks or so through the year.
