We will commence the day with Gathering Worship, then will follow three sessions, each introduced by a short reflection, a time alone to reflect, pray and ponder, with a short group time to conclude.

At the end of the day we will share in Holy Communion. Most of us find it difficult to make space for ourselves in which we can relax, pray, ponder and listen for the promptings of the Spirit. These days are the chance to do that.
