LATEST COVID-19 UPDATES - From UC e-news

July 5th 2021: Update to COVID-19 Restrictions in SA

The Premier and Police Commissioner announced on July 5th, 2021, a relaxation of the COVID-19 restrictions applicable to churches which were enacted last week. Restrictions have now been revised back (effective immediately) to the following:

Density requirements for churches:

- where worshippers are in fixed seating the requirement that worshippers wear masks when more than 75% of the seats are occupied
- where worshippers are not in fixed seating the requirement that worshippers wear masks if the total number of persons present at the place exceeds 3 persons per 4 square metres.

In addition, the following restrictions apply:

- Reasonable steps must be taken to maintain 1.5m physical distancing
- COVID-Safe Plans, QR codes (contact tracing) and COVID Marshals required
- Residential gatherings limited to a maximum of 50 people unrestricted (51-200 requires a COVID-Safe Plan)
- Private gatherings (such as wakes and receptions) 3 person per 4sqm, limited to a maximum of 200 people
- Food and beverages may be consumed whilst standing (no communal service areas such as buffets).

Prayer Points This week we pray for:

- For all nations continuing to cope with the impacts of COVID-19, in particular for India and Cambodia
- For all First Peoples as they celebrate their history, culture and achievements during NAIDOC Week
- For all health workers and medical staff as they continue to work on the frontline of the pandemic.
