#### Jesus Heals a Man Born Blind

John 9: 9 - 12

9 As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. <sup>2</sup> His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"

<sup>3</sup> "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," said Jesus, "but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him. <sup>4</sup> As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. <sup>5</sup> While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." <sup>6</sup> After saying this, he spits on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes.

<sup>7</sup> "Go," he told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means "Sent").

So, the man went and washed, and came home seeing. <sup>8</sup> His neighbors and those who had formerly seen him begging asked, "Isn't this the same man who used to sit and beg?" <sup>9</sup> Some claimed that he was. Others said, "No, he only looks like him." But he himself insisted, "I am the man."

<sup>10</sup> "How then were your eyes opened?" they asked.

<sup>11</sup> He replied, "The man they call Jesus made some mud and put it on my eyes. He told me to go to Siloam and wash. So, I went and washed, and then I could see." <sup>12</sup> "Where is this man?" they asked him. "I don't know." he said.
