#### The Parable of the Growing Seed

<sup>26</sup> He also said, "This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground.<sup>27</sup> Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. <sup>28</sup> All by itself the soil produces grain—first the stalk, then the head, then the full kernel in the head. <sup>29</sup> As soon as the grain is ripe, he puts the sickle to it, because the harvest has come."

#### The Parable of the Mustard Seed

<sup>30</sup> Again he said, "What shall we say the kingdom of God is like, or what parable shall we use to describe it? <sup>31</sup> It is like a mustard seed, which is the smallest of all seeds on earth. <sup>32</sup> Yet when planted, it grows and becomes the largest of all garden plants, with such big branches that the birds can perch in its shade." <sup>33</sup> With many similar parables Jesus spoke the word to them, as much as they could understand. <sup>34</sup> He did not say anything to them without using a parable. But when he was alone with his own disciples, he explained everything.

#### The last 'Big Booksale'

Last weekend we saw our Seacliff Church Community at its very best. Our sincere thanks to all those who helped set up on Friday, managed the sales, sorted the books and cleaned up on Monday afternoon. Many of the better books have 'found another home' in the Myer Centre in the city and at SAVERS at Noarlunga!

#### A few notes of interest:

This year the proceeds from the Booksale itself were \$5,144.59 (a record) and the accompanying Produce sale in the Middle Hall raised \$839.60. The proceeds from the books will support the work of School Chaplains and the proceeds from the Produce Stall will go towards the Oodnadatta Church (2 chairs=\$160) and the work of *Uniting Church Frontier Services*.

This is the 20<sup>th</sup> and final year of the Book sale and Bob estimates that the total proceeds over this time is about \$75,000, a truly amazing contribution from Bob Tuck, our Church community and the customers.

In the corner near the kitchen there are the 'leftovers' which really need to find their way into yellow bins for recycling please. If you are able, please take a box or two of books home this morning and if you need a lift with it, please see me or another ablebodied person to help. I would like to clear these out today please.

While I am on the topic, we may also need to move any remaining boxes of books and empty boxes to the shed after Soapbox, if so we will need some helpers please. It has turned out that we have several dozen surplus broccoli boxes with lids (polystyrene) which can apparently be recycled, or possibly used for Worm Farms! Maureen has some details about recycling if you are able to help in this regard please, otherwise they will need to be broken up and go to landfill.

On the topic of 'recycling', the prize goes to the Winn's when Jim was witnessed to be (re)purchasing a book that Viv had found in their home during a clean-up recently and donated to Bob Tuck for the cause! Who knows how many times this has happened in the past? Nevertheless it is very generous of you both and thank you.
