Safer Church Screening renewals

Since the introduction of the new screening requirements in 2019, reminders for expiring screenings due for renewal have been sent from the Synod's UC SA Screening office. This year the Department for Human Services Screening Unit decided to send notifications to anyone who has a Working With Children Check (WWCC) that is expiring in the next 6 months.

Unfortunately, this has sometimes been sent to individuals before the reminder from this office which has caused some confusion regarding how and through what channels to complete the renewal.
